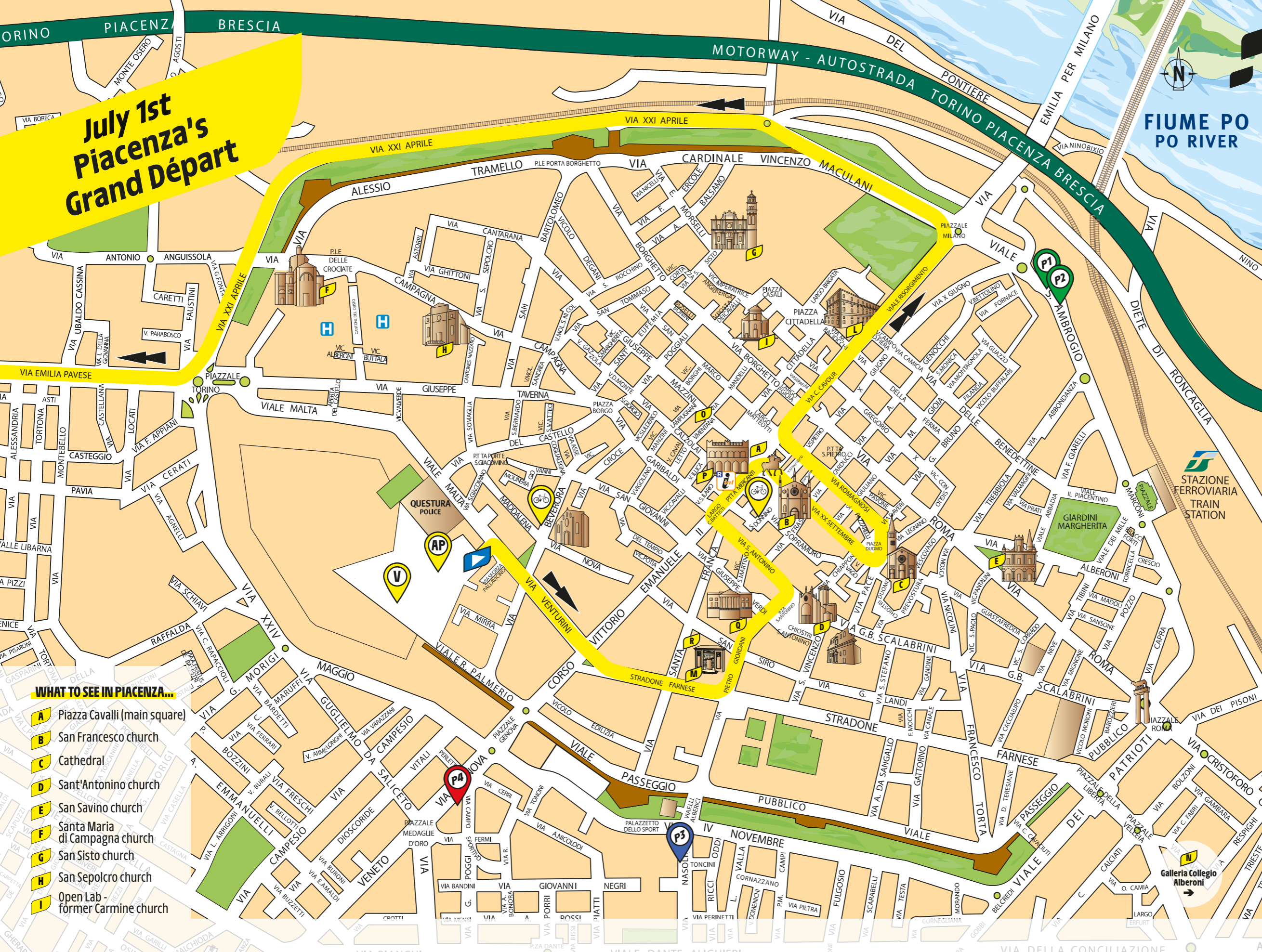


July 1st Piacenza's Grand Départ

THE URBAN ITINERARY
 Departing from the Podium Area next to the Tour Village, the parade will continue along the following streets: viale Malta -> via Venturini -> stradone Farnese -> via Giordani -> piazza Sant'Antonino -> via Sant'Antonino -> largo Battisti -> piazza Cavalli -> via XX Settembre -> piazza Duomo -> via Romagnosi -> via Cavour -> viale Risorgimento -> piazzale Milano -> via XXI Aprile -> piazzale Torino -> via Emilia Pavese up to the river Trebbia bridge in San Nicolò di Rottofreno, where the competitive race will start.

On Monday July 1st, several car parks located in the city centre or near the Tour de France itinerary will be unserviceable or not easily accessible. Don't worry: you can leave your car in the "park and ride" areas and reach the best locations to follow the race by catching the **free shuttle buses** that will be running every ten minutes between 7am and 8pm
